System upgrade of the Perth Concert Hall

AAS members and interested parties are invited to witness the recent upgrade of audio systems within the landmark Perth Concert Hall.

The 1,729 seat Perth Concert Hall is one of the most highly regarded orchestra performance spaces in the southern hemisphere, featuring a 3,000 pipe organ.

The original acoustic design of Professor A. Harold Marshall in association with Warwick Mehaffey of the ABC, approximately 40 years ago, incorporates ornate ceiling coffers and wall features found in many of the great halls worldwide.

To enable greater flexibility and capacity for modern live performances, the 2009 system upgrades of the PCH was designed to account for the complex effects these features contributed.

The meeting will commence at **7:30pm** at the Perth Concert Hall.

With mixer set in position on the night, if anyone has some music they would like to listen to they are welcome to bring it along.

Also, anyone interested in attending the meeting is encouraged to also join us prior the meeting for dinner and drinks at Balti, (across the road at 2 St Georges Terrace), from **6pm** beforehand.
